

# BASEBALL OPERATIONS



I was once a former NCAA All American, a member of the USA National Team, and a First Round draft pick of the Los Angeles Dodgers. I was given an opportunity to play in an MLB Organization, but just two seasons into my professional career, my career took a different path. I underwent shoulder surgery, and my career was never the same. After I retired from baseball, I committed myself to find answers as to why so many players suffer from injuries, poor performance, and never fulfill their potential.

I now have answers and in my role with the USPBL, I want to give players an opportunity to extend their playing careers in hopes of one day signing a contract with an MLB Organization. The USPBL staff is providing a unique developmental system to players who may have been overlooked or may need one or two additional years to refine their skill set.

As Director of Baseball Operations, I'm committed to continually building, implementing, and executing a development system that is proven to increase the skill sets of our players and make them legitimate MLB prospects. In our first two seasons, our development system has produced tremendous results.

Our results are not the work of one person but an entire staff that dedicates their time to the overall improvement of our players. The staff for all the teams in the USPBL collaborate for the benefit of the players. By design, each member of our staff brings a unique skill set to influence our player development on a daily basis.

The knowledge and skills of our staff have had a significant impact in a short period due to how the league is structured. With fewer games and more practices, we create more time to refine and improve the skills of our players. Learning a new skill takes time, and we strive to create an atmosphere that embraces change and allows a player time for the transition to manifest into the game.

The USPBL will continue to revolutionize the way the game is played and practiced. Every year we will assess our efficiency and look to make improvements for the next season. Every player walks down a path towards failure or success in this game. The USPBL wants to give our players the tools and guidance to make sure the path is directed towards success and fulfilling their true potential.

- 4- Aggressively market players to MLB Organizations.





## DEVELOPMENT TOOLS

To prove our development system enhances the skills of our players, we utilize the knowledge of our staff with the resources and technology provided by Delivery Value System (DVS) and FlightScope.

DVS offers a proprietary method to evaluate a pitcher's mechanics (DVS Score), an arm care system built to increase shoulder motion, and a throwing program that prescribes safe throwing distances, soreness protocols, and stresses the repeatability of mechanics.

FlightScope allows the USPBL to establish benchmark metrics of our players and track their progress over the course of the season. All players in the USPBL are able to track how they are progressing concerning the most valuable performance analytics.

## STRUCTURE

The USPBL Season extends from May 11th to September 9th. Each team plays approximately 52 games over a 4.5-month span with every game being played at Jimmy John's Field in Utica, Michigan. Players have unlimited access to an indoor training facility to

evaluate their swing/pitching mechanics, lift weights, and continue to get extra practice time.
