STRUCTURE

All 4 teams play out of Jimmy John's Field as the USPBL Baseball Staff work with players from all 4 teams each week. To help players develop faster, the USPBL plays less games with more skill-based practices.

DEVELOPMENT TOOLS

Players in the USPBL have every opportunity to reach their potential by the resources and development tools offered by the USPBL.

K-Vest: Helps to capture lab quality 3D Data to assess how our players move to create their swing with proven solutions enhance positive swing changes.

DVS Baseball: Since 2016, DVS Baseball has helped pitchers use their medically published mechanical analysis and development system to improve shoulder function and mobility, fastball velocity and command, and help to produce USPBL pitchers into MLB Prospects.

Pitching and Hitting Rapsodo: Real time 3D pitch and hit data used in an indoor setting.

FlightScope: Allows the USPBL to establish benchmark metrics of our players and track their progress over the course of the season.

Custom Player Dashboards: All players in the USPBL have their own custom dashboard that can be viewed by MLB Organizations to track how they are progressing during the season.

Limited Travel: Without the long bus rides to travel to away games, players have more time to train and prepare their body for performance. Indoor Training Facility: Players have access to one of the premier training facilities in Michigan outside of practices.









In 2019, the ultimate goal of the USPBL was accomplished when former Utica Unicorn Randy Dobnak a Major League Baseball game. Dobnak's story and path to reach the MLB through the USPBL embodies our mission of acquiring, developing, and
